

## **LEADERSHIP: FOUR PROBLEMS TO AVOID**

1. Leadership that knows a lot, but does not apply what they know to daily life. They are not an example of what they teach.

(1Corinthians 4:16 and Hebrews 13:7)

2. Leadership that does everything for the congregation, instead of training each person to participate and work together as a team.

(Ephesians 4:11-12)

3. Leadership that keeps everyone busy with activities, instead of helping each person to focus on spending time alone with God and living in obedience.

(Luke 10:38-42)

4. Leadership chosen by academic degrees, personal connections, a large bank account, and natural talents. God prefers leadership chosen because of the person's Biblical qualifications and character.

(Titus 1 and 1 Timothy 3)
